Maintain Their Roads
AUTHORIZATION: 16-246

An annual payment will be made to Greenstone property owners who live on rural roads and who have to pay to maintain those roads.

The roads must not be privately owned, not Municipally owned and not maintained by the Municipality. The road must be a minimum of 150m in length and access must be unrestricted. There must be no other road maintenance funding available (provincial, federal or private).

The annual payment will be made to an Association of the taxpayers, or individual residents, if only one resident lives on the road, of each qualifying rural road. Payment made to such Associations, or individual residents will not exceed 15% of the municipal taxes levied on those property owners and will be based on paid invoices for road maintenance provided to the Municipality.
